Autumn Report Update

I am pleased to enclose your child's termly report for autumn. As you will see, the termly report contains a short review of your child's performance in reading, writing and maths during the autumn term. The report also provides a brief overview of your child's effort and attitude in other areas of their learning as well as a comment upon your child with regards to adhering to our school vision/mission.

When assessing your child's attainment the teachers use their own observations, formative assessments as well as using attainment achieved in Pira Reading tests and Puma maths tests (Year 1-6). The teacher will then give a predicted 'on track' assessment of what they expect your child to achieve by the end of the school year. The following statements are used:

On track to be working towards age related expectations at the end of the year – **Working Towards** On track to achieve age related expectations at the end of the year - **Expected** On track to be working at a greater depth within the age-related expectations – **Greater Depth**

If your child is not predicted to be on track for achieving the expected, age appropriate, level by the end of the current school year, please do not worry as the teacher and support staff will be working with your child throughout the year to help them to accelerate their learning so that they will be on track by the end of the academic year. In addition, where a child is predicted to be working at age related expectations, the staff will ensure that their teaching allows the children to reach the exceeding standard.
