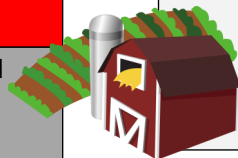

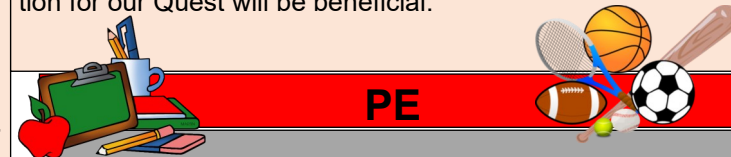
Collective Worship
