## Homework

This year in Oak, maths homework will continue to set via MyMaths every Friday, to be completed by the following Friday. Children should also regularly be practicing their times-tables on TTRS. Weekly competitions are set between the classes. In Oak class we also have our own leaderboard where I will be looking for the top 5 children each week. Children should also be reading on a daily basis. Termly spellings will be sent home at the start of each term for the children to practice. These are organised into weeks however please review these frequently. A spelling bee will then take place at the end of the term based on these spellings for a chance to win counters for your child's team. This term in Oak class, we have now set a day of the week/time for children to change their banded reading book. This will be **every Thursday afternoon**. If your child is not ready to change their book on this day then this is not a problem.

## Collective Worship

Collective worship will take place this year on a Monday and Wednesday, with our celebration worship taking place on a Friday as always. We will also have class worship on a Tuesday and a Thursday. Our value of this term will be Trust and Community.

## Significant person

This year we will continue to introduce to our curriculum a significant person. This is a person who has had a strong impact on our way of life or culture and that we think would be important for the children to know about. For this term, we have chosen Anne Frank who is well known for her diary entries that she wrote during World War 2. Her diary is one of the most important books in history. It tells the story of her life, being a Jewish during World War Two.



## Quest: Invaders

This term in our learning quest we will be learning about invaders such as the Anglo-Saxons. The children will learn why they were such successful invaders and use this knowledge to create a poster/guide on how to carry out a successful invasion.
