


Cottingham CofE Primary School Termly Information

Term: 1

Homework

This year in Oak, maths homework will continue to set via MyMaths every Friday, to be completed by the following Friday. Children should also be reading on a daily basis. Termly spellings will be sent home shortly. These are organized into weeks however please review these frequently.

Quest: What were the achieements of the earliest civilisations?

In this quest, children will be finding out all about the Ancient Egyptians, their way of life and landscape and how artefacts have an impact on history.

PE days

This term, PE in Oak will take place on a Tuesday and Friday afternoon. Children will be allowed to come to school in their PE kits on these two days.



Collective Worship

Collective worship will take place this year on a Monday and Wednesday, with our celebration worship taking place on a Friday as always. We will also have class worship on a Tuesday and a Thursday.

Homework ideas

As always, we are sharing a range of ideas for you to support the children with their learning quest work at home. Our first quest is about Mountains and life cycles. To support your child at home you might like to research about the Ancient Egyptians. We will also be learning about Imhotep in our learning quest this term, your child might want to find out more about our significant person by finding out why they are famous and what impact they had on Britain.

Important information

Please note that from September onwards children in key stage 2 will only be allowed to take fruit or veg out onto the playground at break time for their snack. Please note we are a nut and kiwi free school.

Significant person

This year we will continue to introduce to our curriculum a significant person.
