

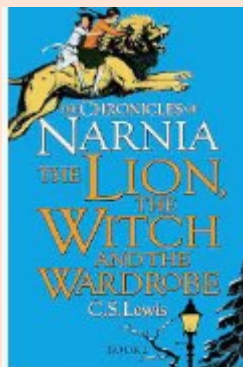
Spring Term 2—Oak Class News—2023/24
