Quest: How does your garden grow?

The children will be learning to name common flowering plants including trees, naming parts of the plant and what a plant needs for healthy growth.

PE days

All Year 1 children will have PE lessons on Mondays and Thursdays. Please ensure that your child is wearing PE uniform on these days.

Collective Worship
