As you know, this week across the country, sees year 6 children sit their end of year 6 assessments. Known more commonly as the SATS, this is a chance for the children to show all that they have learnt since year 3! Throughout the week, the children will sit assessments of their spelling, grammar, arithmetic, reading and mathematical reasoning. The collection of the assessments is like a military operation and we will find out just how well the children have done by the end of June. On Monday, we received an unannounced visit from the Local Authority as part of their monitoring to ensure that the assessments are carried out as they should be. Needless to say, we passed the monitoring with flying colours and everything was as it should be. I would also like to thank the staff for their help before school. Mrs George has been busy preparing breakfast each day so I am sure all of the children will join me in saying 'THANK YOU!' I am personally hoping for Mrs George's famous pancakes and sauce. Good luck to the children for the rest of the week. Once the SATS are over it is the turn of the year 2 children to have their knowledge and understanding assessed. Their assessments will begin at the end of the week and continue into next. If you have any questions about these or the forthcoming year 1 phonics assessments, please do contact Mrs Wilson and/or Mrs Delo. It will now be business as usual for the Year 6 children. As writing is no longer assessed during a formal assessment, Mrs Wason will be preparing the children's writing and assessing herself. There is every chance that we will receive a Local Authority moderation of these assessments. If this is the case, we will all be as prepared as we can be.

Mrs Delo and I will soon be welcoming our 2019 new starter parents to school for an information evening. This is something that I look forward to every year. As you know, we are oversubscribed for September. Although it is not nice to turn children away, it is very rewarding that the school will be full in Reception from September. This is down to the hard work of Mrs Delo, the staff, children and the whole community. Word spreads and we are thankful for the kind messages that you offer. This week, we have welcomed two new children into both year 3 and 5 respectively. A successful school will be a full school. There are still places available throughout the year groups. Please spread that message. I am more than happy to show parents and their children around the school at any time. All they need do is make an appointment.

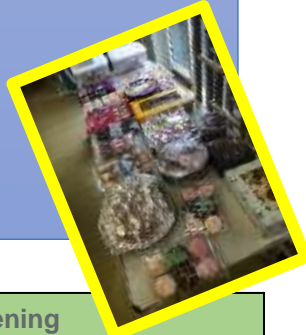
