#### **SENDCO**

As you will know, Mrs Freeman left us at the end of the summer term. Fortunately I was able to replace her with Mrs Redman who is an experienced SENDCo. Mrs Redman will be with us on a fortnightly basis and she has posted this message below:

I feel privileged to have taken up the post of SENCO at Cottingham School. I live locally and have worked in several Northamptonshire schools as SENCO (and previously class teacher) since 2007. I have been fortunate to have worked with the Local Authority for part of this time, which has enabled me to develop a great network within local SEN circles which can be contacted to support children with SEND. My philosophy is simple - I work hard to support children as I would want my own two children (now 18 and 20) to be supported. There are lots of creative and often simple reasonable adjustments we can make in school to really make a difference for children in their learning. I have worked with children today to update their views on their passports. Staff are updating targets and I will email the passports out to parents when they are all complete.

I will be contacting parents over the next few weeks and we can meet to plan next steps for your child.

My working days here will normally be a Monday - once a fortnight. My days will be 18th September, 2nd Oct, 16th October and so on.... Communication is vital to my role and I welcome emails from you. I will respond as soon as I can to them. My email is H.Redman@cottingham.pdet.org.uk



















## **Governors Update**


