Attendance (Holidays!)



Already this term, a number of requests have been submitted regarding term time holidays. As always, any term time requests for holidays will **not** be approved unless in exceptional circumstances. Currently, the whole school attendance is 97.6%. Unauthorised absence is at 1.8% which is above the national average.

In line with guidance, looking ahead, if you request term time absence for holidays, a letter will be sent home explaining that the request is **not** approved and that their is a possibility that a fine will be issued (to both parents) from the local authority. As you will know, attendance if key to a child

making the best progress possible. Thank you for your support with ensuring that your children are in school on time with just 0.07% lateness at the moment.

This information is taken directly from the North Northants website with regards to penalty notices that may bi issued.

- Penalty notices for non-school attendance to issue a penalty notice, there should be 5 days (10 sessions) or more unauthorised absences in a 6 week period.
- Penalty notices for term time absence to issue a penalty notice, there should be 5 days (10 sessions) or more of consecutive unauthorised absence.

Further Information

The text below is an example of what you could receive from school once a holiday request has been made. Any penalty notice will be issued directly from the local authority.

Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you for filling out an absence from school form. I have taken your request into careful consideration.

If any family make a holiday request that is for 5 days, it can be reported to the local authority. The request for holidays in term time is UNAUTHORISED unless for exceptional circumstances. As an education provider, we are held responsible for academic progress and the impact of this due to time taken out of school. Therefore, a penalty notice may be issued by the local authority – North Northamptonshire Council.

Pupil Premium



UIFSM is for all EYFS and KS1 children. This results in these children receiving the current offer of a free lunch. You may still be eligible for **Pupil Premium** which is totally different. We actively encourage you to find out whether your child is eligible to receive this funding. You can find out more information on the school website via <u>Pupil Premium - Cottingham Primary</u> Each year our offer

will change according to funding and learning priorities. Please contact the school office as soon as possible if your are in receipt of any of the benefits below:

Eligibility

You may be entitled to free school meals for your child(ren) if you receive one of the following benefits:

- 1.Income Support
- 2.Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- 3. Child Tax Credit Only (with income up to £16,190) with no element of Working Tax Credit
- 4. National Asylum Seekers Support
- 5. Guarantee Element of the State Pension Credit
- 6.Employment and Support Allowance
- 7. Universal Credit (Income Related)

All contacts will be treated with confidence and is a quick process.

ART


